

Safety

Instructions



Inspect the system before any deployment.

Upgrade procedure

About this task

Kara can be upgraded to Kara II by replacing the Kara fins with Kara II L-Fins.

One KARA II UPG upgrade kit is necessary for the upgrade of one Kara to Kara II.



Performing maintenance on Kara enclosures upgraded to Kara II

Kara and Kara II compression drivers have different connector types.

Use Kara repair kits on upgraded enclosures for the following parts:

HF compression driver: KR HPBC34

HF diaphragm: KR HSBC34


For all other parts, Kara II repair kits can be used.

Tools

- torque screwdriver
- 5 mm hex bit
- T30 Torx bit
- flat plastic tool (optional)



Panflex upgrade kit for Kara (includes Panflex fins and Kara II sticker)




Procedure


1. Remove the two fins from Kara.




2. Remove the dust cover.




- 0
- Remove any old dust cover material and dust before applying the new dust cover.
- **3.** Place the new dust cover with the gaskets against the cabinet.




Make sure the news fins are open. If they are closed, use a flat tool to unhook the fins clips.



4. Secure the new fins on Kara with the S100143 screws.




5. Push on the fins to close them.



- 6. Carefully stick the Kara II label on top of the Kara label, at the rear of the enclosure.
 - Make sure the serial number remains visible through the label window.

 If the serial number is hidden by the new label (Kara model from 2014 or earlier), copy the number on the empty serial number label, and stick the label inside the window.
